For Families with Children...

- Children are always welcome in the worship service, but there are times when the need arises to remove a child from the worship setting. Speakers are located in both entryways. While we encourage families to worship together, we ask all to respect the worship of others. If your child becomes restless, please step outside the worship area or use the nursery room (Room 101, through the North doors).
- **Nursing Mothers** may use our Quiet Room during the worship service. This is in Room 104 (through the North doors) with rocking chairs and the worship service is available for viewing by following the directions on the television.
- **Children's "Quiet Bags"** are located in the white cabinet at the back of the church to help occupy small children during the worship service.

During the 10:30 service...

- Our **Nursery** (Room 101) is staffed with two adult volunteers. Parents are welcome to leave their children in their care or remain in the nursery with their child.
- **Children's Church** is for children who are in Pre-Kindergarten and under. You may take your child to Children's Church when indicated in the Worship Folder and on the Projection Screens. Children's Church is in Room 102 (through the North doors).

BLOOD PRESSURE CHECKS - You can have your blood pressure checked between services by a Parish Nurse in the Fellowship Hall today.

TODAY IN SUNDAY SCHOOL - Today in Sunday School, we will talk about how Jesus teaches the disciples to pray. (Matthew 6:9-15; Luke 11:1-13) Talk to your children about the Lord's Prayer and pray with them the prayer that Jesus has taught us.

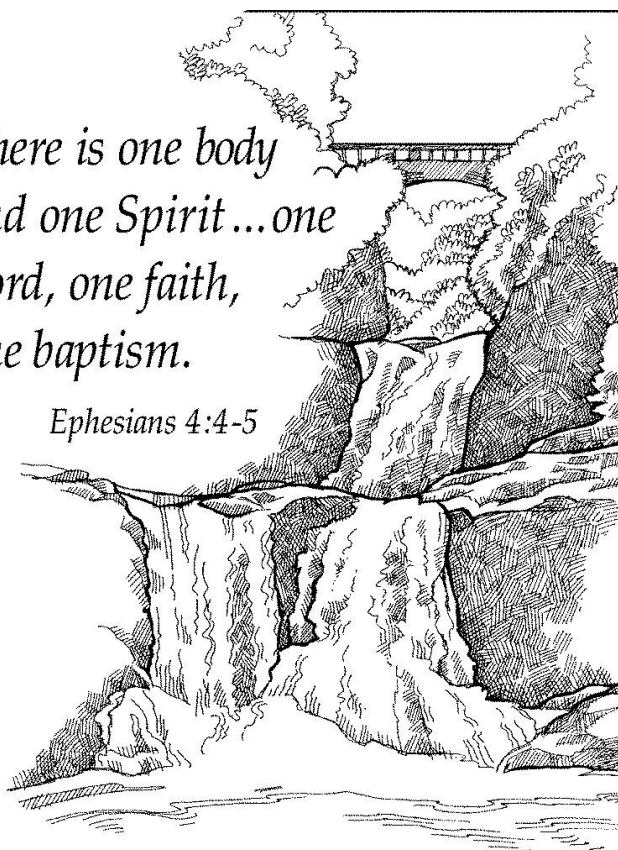
