

Toilet Paper Tube Angel Craft

Supply List:

- 1 toilet paper tube
- pencil or pen
- ruler (optional)
- scissors
- Elmer's glue (or a gluestick)
- 3 paper clips (optional)
- markers, sequins, glitter, etc. for decorating (optional)



Instructions:

1. Flatten a toilet paper tube (without cutting it apart.)
2. Mark the flattened tube approx. every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch.
3. Cut through both layers of the tube on your marks. You should have at least 8 looped strips.
4. Take 3 of the looped strips and pinch together at one end to form the gown of the angel. (See picture above.) Glue together where pinched on one end and secure with a paper clip until the glue dries.
5. Take another 3 looped strips and pinch in the middle to form the angel wings. (See picture above.) Glue the centers of the strips together where you have it pinched in the middle. Secure with a paper clip until the glue dries.
6. Take one of the remaining looped strips and cut it apart. Form into a circle to make the head of the angel. Glue the ends of the circle together to form the head and secure with a paper clip until dry.
7. When the 3 parts of the angel are dry, remove paper clips. Glue the gown to the bottom of the wings and the head to the top of the wings as shown above. Hold together with your fingers until each part is set.
8. You can decorate your angel with markers, sequins, glitter and glue, or just leave it plain.
9. You can cut the last strip of the toilet paper tube apart and loop through the head to form a hanger for your angel ornament as shown above, or you can make a hanger out of yarn or ribbon.
